MARYLAND BILL SIGNING TODAY – PAID SICK LEAVE BILL VETOED

Governor Hogan signed over two hundred bills into law today. For the full list of bills please see the following link:

Notably, the Governor announced he will veto HB 1 – Labor and Employment – Maryland Healthy Working Families Act, commonly referred to as “Paid Sick Leave” legislation. Please see the link below for more information regarding the veto:

Finally, Governor Hogan announced three executive orders pertaining to paid sick leave. The first order creates a Task Force that will study the issue and report back by December 2017. The second order institutes paid sick leave for all Maryland State Employees. The final order creates a procurement preference for entities that offer paid sick leave to their employees.
